WORK SESSION

JULY 5, 2016

On Tuesday, July 5, 2016 the Mayor and Town Council convened in a work session at 4:30pm at the Train Station on Belt Street, Snow Hill, Maryland.

PUBLIC OFFICIALS PRESENT

Mayor John Dorman; Councilwoman Alison Cook; Councilman Michael Pruitt; and Councilwoman Jenny Hall.

STAFF IN ATTENDANCE

Kelly Pruitt, Town Manager; Trish Goodsell, Asst. to the Town Manager

COMPREHENSIVE REZONING DRAFT

Kelly Pruitt, Town Manager provided the Mayor and Council with drafted comments to be added to the comprehensive rezoning plan. These comments will need to be reviewed and will be discussed at the next work session.

WORK SESSIONS

The Mayor and Council discussed changing the time for all work sessions back to 4:30pm, as there is very little to no attendance at the 6:00pm session. Councilwoman Hall and Councilman Pruitt stated that they prefer the 4:30pm sessions; however, the Mayor and Council all agreed that they would like to have quarterly meetings that are held at 6:00pm.

The decision was to return the work sessions to 4:30pm and the next quarterly work session will be held on October 25, 2016. More information will be provided at a later date.

Councilman Pruitt gave a motion to enter closed session to discuss personnel, business development and legal matters. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Hall. A roll call vote was taken and the motion was carried.

CLOSED SESSION SUMMARY

Following a motion by Councilman Pruitt, seconded by Councilwoman Hall, the Council voted to meet in closed session at 4:37pm at the Train Station to discuss personnel matters, business matters and legal matters, as permitted under the provision of Section 3-305 of the State Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. Additional staff present at the closed session was: John C. Dorman, Mayor; Kelly Pruitt, Town Manager; Trish Goodsell, Asst. to the Town Manager, and Michael Day, Economic Development Coordinator. Topic discussed and actions taken included:

- Personnel – fire department and police department
- Legal matter – discussed legal matters for potential development
- Business – discussion regarding potential new business proposals

Mayor Dorman left Executive Closed Session at 6:22pm and entered into Open Session.
