

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

The “5 Bin” Method — Place Curbside for Thursday Morning Pick Up

#1 PLASTIC

YES

All plastic is accepted including caps. Containers are marked with a recycling symbol ♻️ with the number 1 through 7

NO

Styrofoam, Packing “peanuts”, Plastic film, wrap, or bags.

#2 GLASS

YES

All intact glass containers are recyclable. Any color glass is accepted.

NO

Broken glass, Mirrors, Window glass, Light bulbs

#3 METAL

YES

All aluminum and metal cans including can lids

NO

Aluminum foil, Coat hangers, Pipe, Metal construction debris, Scrap metal

#4 PAPER

YES

All paper, newspaper, shredded paper, magazines, envelopes (including window envelopes), phone books, books, gift-wrap.

Paper does not need to be separated. Place it curbside in a paper bag or loose in your recycling bin.

Schedule

| Mon | <u>Limbs</u> up to 8 inches in diameter (no roots) |
| Tues | <u>Trash</u> (household garbage), including bagged leaves and grass clippings |
| Weds | <u>Bulk</u> items, call for fees and schedule 410-632-2080 |
| Thurs | <u>Recycling</u> (use 5 “bins”) |

#5 CARDBOARD

YES

Corrugated boxes and non-corrugated cardboard (example: cereal & cracker boxes) are accepted.

Cardboard does not need to be separated. Place it flat, curbside in a paper bag or loose in your recycling bin.

RECYCLING DO'S AND DON'TS

- ✓ DO rinse all cans, jars and containers
- ✓ Labels DO NOT need to be removed
- ✗ DO NOT recycle packaging composed of unlike materials, e.g. juice boxes with foil liners, waxed boxes or milk cartons
- ✓ When in doubt — RECYCLE the waste




BULK TRASH & YARD WASTE

- Place limbs at curb for Monday pickup
- Place leaves and grass clippings with regular trash on Tuesdays.
- The County accepts “bulk” items at the landfill for recycling such as appliances, electronics and computers, as well as used motor oil and batteries. Call 410-632-3177
- Bulk trash can be picked up by the town for a fee, call Town Hall at 410-632-2080

RECYCLING FACTS

- 75% of household trash is recyclable
- Current landfill rates in Worcester County is \$55/ton. Recycled waste is \$0.
- Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to run a TV for 3 hours.
- There is no limit to the number of times an aluminum can can be recycled.
- To produce each week’s Sunday newspapers, 500,000 trees must be cut down.
- The average household throws away 13,000 separate pieces of paper each year. Most is packaging and junk mail.
- Americans use 2.5 million plastic bottles every hour! Most are thrown away! Recycling saves valuable landfill space.
